

TOWN OF BERWICK BYLAW

SKATEBOARDING

The Council of the Town of Berwick, pursuant to the provisions of Section 153N of the TOWNS ACT, hereby enacts the following:

SECTION 1

Definitions:

For the purposes of this Bylaw:

- (a) “Sidewalk” means any public path, lane, walkway, or other area designated for pedestrian travel or use;
- (b) “Skateboard” means a board constructed of any material which has affixed thereto rollers or wheels designed to be mounted or operated by any individual or individuals;
- (c) “Town” means the Town of BERWICK;
- (d) “Prohibited Area” is that section of Commercial Street, including all sidewalks, bounded by the intersection of Cottage Street and Commercial Street; and on the other end, bounded by the intersection of Mill Street and Commercial Street (see “Appendix A” : map with prohibited area indicated).

SECTION 2

Offence

It shall be an offence to use or operate a skateboard on the section of Commercial Street identified as a “Prohibited Area”; specifically, that section of Commercial Street, including all sidewalks, bounded by the intersection of Cottage Street on the northern most end, and bounded by Mill Street on the southern most end. (See “Appendix A”: map with PROHIBITED AREA clearly indicated).

SECTION 3

Penalty

Every person who contravenes or fails to comply with any of the provisions of this Bylaw shall be liable to a penalty not exceeding \$50.00 for each offence.
