



**As a follow-up to the provincial announcement made on Friday May 15, 2020:
The Town of Berwick Department of Community Development and Recreation
wishes to clarify the re-opening of parks and greenspaces in the Town of Berwick.**

Bookings and Equipment Loan

- In order to adhere to provincial public health measures, no bookings of sports fields, ball fields or other Town owned facilities will be permitted.
- The basketballs at Rainforth Park have been temporarily removed and shuffleboard equipment is not available for loan at this time.

Open:

- Rainforth Park (**Excluding playground**)
- Centennial Park
- Apple Capital Heritage Trail – Harvest Moon Trail
- KMCC Connector Trail
- Chute Park
- Spicer Park (**Excluding playground**)
- Peter Connell Memorial Park
- Community Gardens

Closed:

- **Playgrounds**
- **Splash Pad**
- **Carol's Place building including washroom facilities** – the Town's standard process is to open these in June and will provide updates when the State of Emergency is lifted.
- **Tennis Courts at Rainforth Park** – these are currently under construction, the Town of Berwick will continue to provide updates on the status of this project.

***Residents are reminded that the Provincial State of Emergency remains in effect.
