The primary role of the Police Services Advisory Committee, as outlined in section 68 of the Police Services Act, is to provide advice to Town Council in relation to the enforcement of law, the maintenance of law and order and the prevention of crime in the municipality. Membership on the Police Services Advisory Committee is appointed by Council by resolution. We welcome individuals with diverse backgrounds and encourage interested persons to self-identify.

Requirements and criteria include:

- Resident of the Town of Berwick
- Be independent (not related to a member of Town Council or an employee of the municipality) with no conflicts of interest
- Satisfactory Criminal record check
- Able to demonstrate a willingness to learn and an interest in the Police Services in Berwick.
- Able to attend bi-monthly meetings (evening).
